



COOPERSTOWN ALL STAR VILLAGE LAUNDRY GUIDELINES

To help us deliver a smooth and efficient experience, we ask that all teams follow the guidelines outlined. These procedures are designed to ensure that uniforms and gear are cleaned and returned accurately and on time.

Please review the following instructions



TEAM LAUNDRY SERVICE

Labeling Uniforms:

Try on all your jerseys and cage jackets. Do not write on anything until you have the correct size. If you have to exchange an item after it is written on, you will have to purchase a new jersey. Label all articles of clothing using a permanent marker with your bunkhouse room number and initials. This makes it easier to find if something falls out.

Team Laundry Bags and Bins:

- Your team will be provided with colored laundry bags in the bunkhouse
- All laundry bags must match the color of the label on your team's bin. This helps us keep items organized and returned correctly.
- Laundry bins are labeled with the same color as your laundry bag, along with which floor you are on. (Ex. Top, Middle, Bottom)

Game Days Only

- No laundry service is available on check-in day. Laundry service for team uniforms takes place on **tournament days 2-5 ONLY**



TEAM LAUNDRY SERVICE

Laundry Submission

- Following your team's last game of the day, please place your laundry in the corresponding bin within **30 minutes after the game** has ended
 - Last pick-up is at 1am unless otherwise stated due to rain delays
- All laundry must be put in the provided laundry bag then in the laundry bins
- Please use laundry loops whenever possible.
- Mesh bags are discouraged and should be avoided.

Gear permitted in Laundry Service

- Players: Jerseys, pants, socks, sliding shorts, chest protectors, undershirts and cage jackets
- Coaches: Polos, pants and cage jackets

Lost & Found

- Lost and found items from team laundry can be retrieved from the Baseball Operations Field Office located near Field 7.
