Our mission is to inspire remarkable experiences. We aim to provide a positive experience for all who visit our complex while upholding the spirit and integrity of the game.

By attending a tournament at Cooperstown All Star Village, you are acknowledging that you, too, play a role in the creation of remarkable experiences. We expect you to do so in a positive manner. Demeaning and/or unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and is subject to disciplinary action.

I, hereby, acknowledge the following rules/prohibitions:

- Tobacco and/or alcohol are at all times prohibited in the Cooperstown All Star Village player village, all baseball fields, dugouts, and spectator dugouts.
- Weapons (including but not limited to firearms) and illegal drugs are prohibited at Cooperstown All Star Village,
- Use of demeaning, threatening or profane language to or directed at any player, coach, spectator, umpire or staff member is prohibited
- Umpires are to be treated with respect and professional courtesy
- Use of illegal and/or altered equipment is prohibited
- All electronic devices other than PitchCom are prohibited on the field, additionally Cooperstown All Star Village will not use video for a ruling on the field.
- Only registered coaches and players are permitted in the dugout and on the field
- Use of noisemakers in the during games is prohibited

As a coach, player, parent or other influencer of teams participating at Cooperstown All Star Village, I pledge to:

- Provide a safe environment for all participants, avoiding physical or verbal harm
- Encourage and demonstrate fair play, sportsmanship, hustle, development above winning, self-control, respect and positive support of all players and opponents
- Maintain quality and cleanliness of Cooperstown All Star Village, satellite field facilities and lodging accommodations/community partners by cleaning up trash, caring for equipment and fixtures and not littering
- Have fun and enjoy the spirit of the game of baseball
- Support letting the players play, the coaches coach, the umpires umpire.
- Respect campus property by refraining from stealing or vandalizing in any location, including the bunkhouses and all Cooperstown All Star Village retail locations.

Should I fail to abide by the above Code of Conduct, I understand that I may be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to:

- Verbal warning
- Confinement (to the dugout or other designated area)
- Restricted use of equipment or item involved in situation
- Ejection from the game
- Game forfeiture and/or adjusted seeding
- Suspension from Cooperstown All Star Village for any length of time, including permanently

If you are caught stealing or vandalizing anywhere on campus your entire team is subject to immediate dismissal from the tournament and removal from the property, no refund or credit will be issued. Security cameras have been added in the bunkhouse areas in case of an incident that needs further investigation.
