Tournament Play:

Teams play two (2) games daily - Day 1 thru Day 4.

The first game of the single elimination CTC Championship Tournament begins Day 5 at 7:00 am.

Game Day:

The home team wears the Cooperstown All Star Village White uniforms. The visiting team wears the Cooperstown All Star Village blue uniforms. For the home team, batting practice will be held 55 min, prior to the game. The visiting team's batting practice will be 35 min, prior to game. Pre game infield is not permitted. Teams may hit balls to players in the outfield area 15 minutes before the game. Note: Batting practice is 20 minutes per team.

Visitor Rules

Visitors are not allowed in the Player Village After 4:30 pm on Day 1.0nly players, coaches and umpires are allowed in the Player Village. Coaches are responsible for all their players from the time they arrive at Cooperstown All Star Village until they leave for home.

Before any player leaves the park, an All Star Sign-Out form must be completed by the player's coach and the players parent/guardian. This completed form is then submitted to Security upon exiting the Player Village. When the player returns to the Player Village, the form must be signed again. All coaches are issued All Star Sign-Out forms as part of their registration packet. If additional forms are required, blanks are available at Security. Please obey the "Restricted Areas" signs. For the safety of you and your family, please walk only on paved areas.

Please Note:

Outside coolers, food and beverages of any kind are not permitted on any part of the Village grounds.

RULES AND POLICIES

VIOLATION OF ANY OF THESE RULES COULD RESULT IN SPECTATOR, COACH, PLAYER OR TEAM SUSPENSION OR EJECTION FROM THE TOURNAMENT FOR THE REMAINDER OF YOUR STAY

Player Village Rules:

- Coaches are responsible for their Players at all times. No Player is to be unaccompanied at any time.
- Absolutely no alcohol or tobacco products of any kind.
- Practice is restricted to the Batting Cages and the Practice Field.
- Absolutely no outside food or beverages except bottled water in the bunkhouses
- Only those wearing the wristband provided by CASV are allowed in the Player Village after 4:30 pm on Day 1. Players and Coaches MUST have their wristband on at all times. If a wristband is broken you MUST bring the broken wristband to Baseball Operations for a replacement. You will NOT get a replacement band without the old one.
- Each team may bring ONE large cooler to keep in their Bunkhouse for water ONLY.
- Please walk on the walkways only. No running, sliding, etc. on the hills.
- . Stay off the stone walls, the fountains and the statues.
- Do not throw ANYTHING rocks, stones, balls, etc.

- SAFETY FIRST no horseplay.
- Batting helmets MUST be worn in the Batting Cages. Pitching is allowed ONLY from behind the "L" screen.
- · Stay off the fields unless you are playing in a game.
- Please be aware of the park vehicles that may be in the walkways from time to time as they move from field to field.
- · No Golf Cart rides for Players/Coaches at any time.
- · Absolutely no horseplay in the Bathhouse.
- . No player is allowed in the pool area without a coach.

General All Star Village Rules:

- No alcohol outside of the designated areas The Tavern, the Overlook and Babes' Bar
- Smoking is allowed ONLY in the designated smoking areas.
 Absolutely no smoking inside any building, in the Player Village or in the Ballfield area.
- Players, coaches, umpire, parents and other spectators will practice good sportsmanship at all times.
- In the event of extreme weather Players and Coaches will be directed to return to their Bunkhouse. Parents/Guests should wait in their Hotel room, the Tayern or in their vehicle.
- No pets or other animals, other than ADA Service Animals that are providing a service (No Service animals "In Training" or other non ADA service animals)
- No profanity or fighting.
- No skateboards, roller blades, rolling sneakers, scooters, bikes or other wheeled devices.
- No drones.
- No noisemakers other than for the Opening Ceremonies
- No tents or other canopies.
- No photos or video recording at the ballfields other than with a cell phone.

If you have an emergency while at Cooperstown All Star Village, contact the nearest sta ffmember for assistance, or report the emergency to Security. Our infirmary is staffed 24-hours per day.

If you are off All Star Village property and take a player to the hospital, call the All Star Village office so that we may promptly get the player's health history record to the hospital. Additionally, it is very important that our medical staff its made aware of any medical problem that the player might have while here so proper follow-up treatment is provided.

Fire Drill/Emergency Evacuation

When the alarm sounds, coaches escort their teams in full to the 50 State Arena. Once there, Coaches must do the following:

- 1. Roll Call. Report any missing players to security.
- 2. Keep players together until an All-Clear is given by Security.

Evacuate via roads as directed or by a designated emergency official. Under NYCRR Part 1195, signs are posted in each building.

Teams exit building via exit doors and windows, assemble and leave as a group. Under NYCRR part 1193.1B

ALL FIRES MUST BE REPORTED TO ALL STAR VILLAGE STAFF. NO ONE IS TO TOUCH ANY FIRE (WARNING OR FIGHTING) EQUIPMENT EXCEPT DURING AN ACTUAL EMERGENCY.
