



PLAYER VILLAGE MOVE-OUT POLICY

To ensure the safety and security of all players during the move-out process while allowing parents and guardians to assist with packing and departure.

Who This Applies To

This policy applies to:

- Parents and legal guardians of participating players
- Participating players
- Cooperstown All Star Village staff and security personnel

Player Sign-Out Procedure

- Parents or legal guardians must report to either the Upper Security Booth or Lower Security Booth to begin the sign-out process.
- The player must meet their parent or guardian at the security booth before they may be signed out.
- Once the parent or guardian has been verified, the player's Player Village wristband will be removed by security staff.
- The parent or guardian will be issued a Visitor Badge labeled with their player's bunkhouse number.

Visitor Badge Requirement

- Visitor Badges must be worn and visible at all times while inside Player Village.
- Visitor Badges are valid only for the assigned bunkhouse and move-out assistance.
- Parents and guardians should proceed directly to and from their player's bunkhouse while assisting with move-out.

Security & Access

- Only individuals wearing a valid Player Village wristband or Visitor Badge are permitted inside Player Village.
- Security personnel may request to verify identification or visitor credentials at any time.
- Anyone found inside Player Village without a valid wristband or Visitor Badge will be asked to leave immediately.
- Cooperstown All Star Village reserves the right to deny or revoke access for anyone who does not comply with this policy.
